

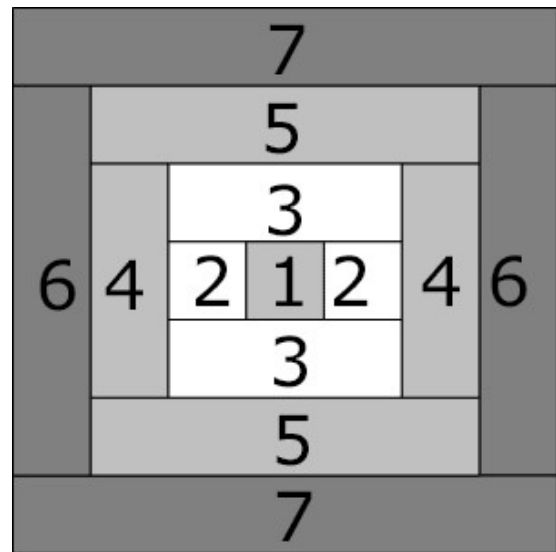
Amish Squares Quilt Block

The Amish Squares quilt block is one of many variations on the Courthouse Steps quilt blocks.

Easier to piece than a standard Log Cabin because you can add patches to both sides of a unit before pressing—this makes for much faster piecing without losing any accuracy.
