

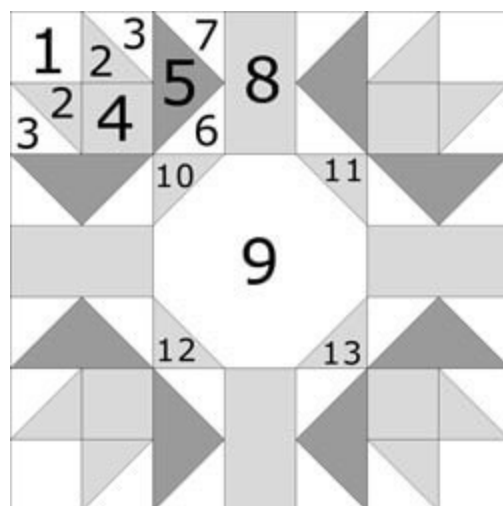
Calgary Stampede Quilt Block


Traditional techniques used to make this block:

- Flying Geese made 4-at-a-time
- HST made 8-at-a-time
- Connector corners or 'sew and flip'
