

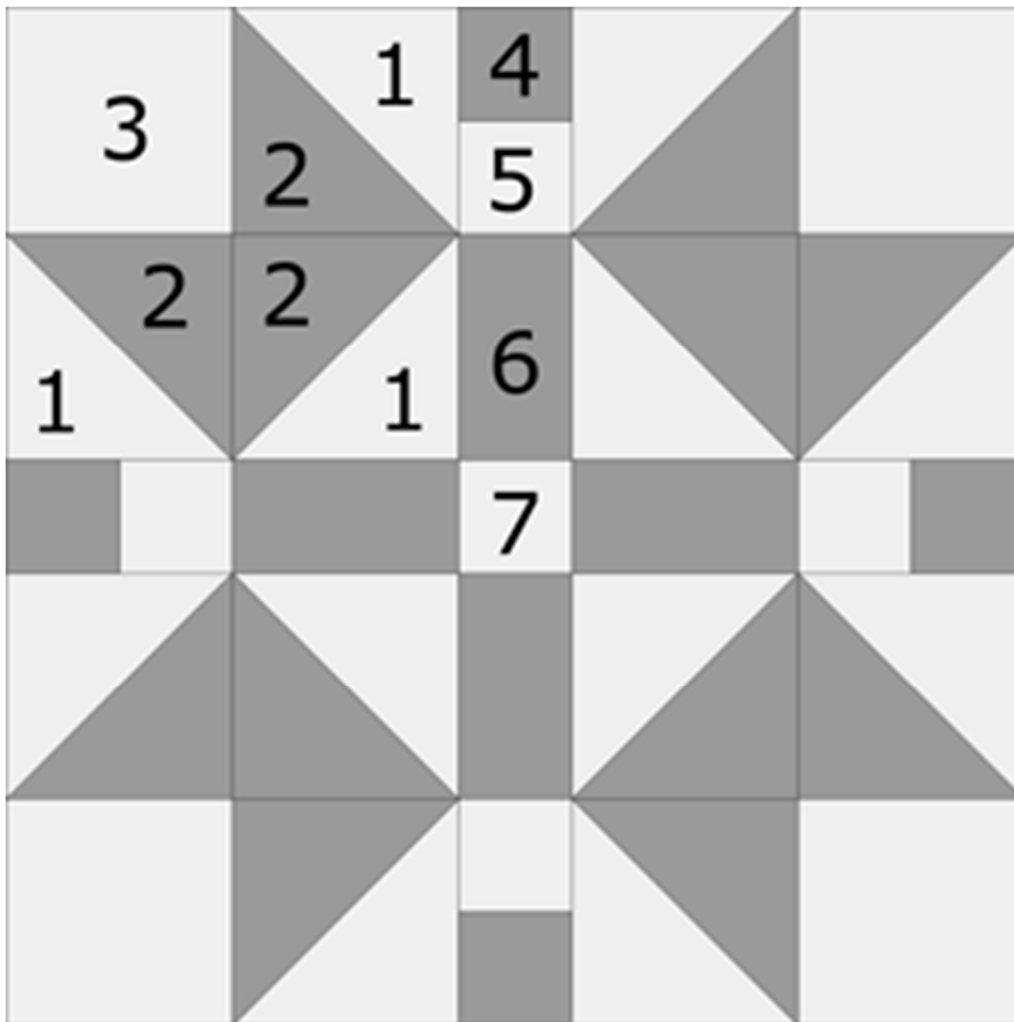
Continental Quilt Block

Techniques used in construction:

- Quick-pieced half square triangles
- Strip piecing

****I prefer to cut my patches extra large for HST, stitch, and then trim them to size. If you prefer to do the same, add a bit extra to the measurements for Patches #1 and #2 above.**
