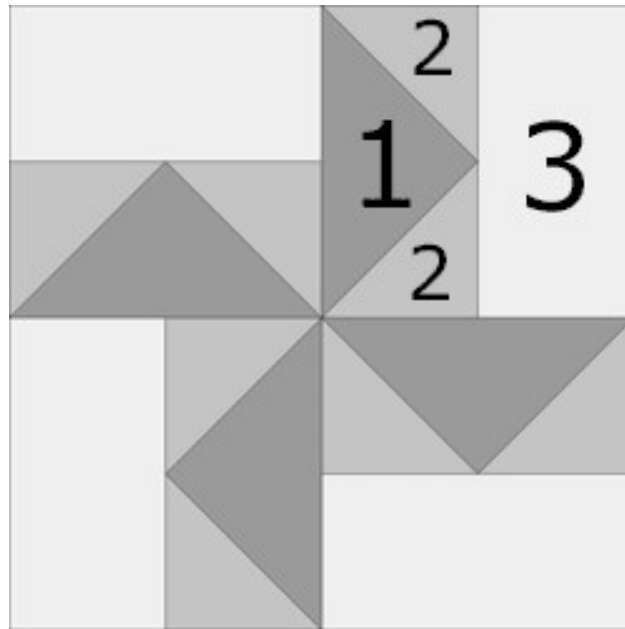



## Louisiana Quilt Block Cutting Chart Traditional Piecing
